Notes :

- Reference item No. 4 of the application form, full annual Membership subscription is to be paid for primary panel membership and 50% extra for each secondary panel membership. Admission Fee will be, however, only for primary panel.
- In the case of any member admitted to the membership of the Association in the second half of any year i.e. after 30th September, the subscription for that year shall be one-half of the subscription otherwise payable. However, admission fee shall be paid in full.
- Turnover in the case of ordinary members shall be for the year preceding the year in which membership application is submitted.

Aims and Objects of AIBA, New Delhi

- i) to promote and safeguard the overall interests of Biotechnology as a science, profession, industry or trade.
- ii) to collect and obtain all information, on matters affecting the members, make representations to the various authorities, and to appear before any Authority in the interest of, protection and betterment of the constituent members for carrying on any activity relating to Biotechnology and to publish and circulate these and any other matter to members and others.
- iii) to cooperate with other individuals, associations, groups and bodies within the country and abroad having similar aims and objects.
- iv) to subscribe and promote the aims and objects of any Society or Association having similar objects to all or any of the objects of the Association or Government Policy for the improvement of laws relating to Biotechnology.
- v) to promote and advance the development of Biotechnology and to coordinate and establish just and equitable principles and practices in this field.
- vi) to coordinate and assist the research, professional, manufacturing and export promotion activities of its constituent members.
- vii) to sponsor study and business teams abroad and to invite individuals, experts & scientists and similar delegations from abroad with the approval of concerned authorities.
- viii) to sponsor and undertake research, commodity and market surveys and collect and disseminate statistics and information and initiate necessary action therewith.
- ix) to undertake publicity through various media and to participate in and organise trade fairs and exhibitions.
- x) to prepare, print and publish papers, periodicals or reports and to organise lectures, conferences and seminars and promote exhibitions, shows and other activities with a view to extending knowledge and information or seeking re-orientation of Government Policy in relation to Biotechnology as a research, industrial, professional or trading activity.
- xi) to provide common services for the benefit of constituent members and to act generally as the forum for promotion, growth or development of biotechnology and publish charts, catalogues, directories, periodicals, leaflets, statistics, magazines, journals, books and other publications and circulate these.
- xii) to provide facilities for settlement of disputes within the ambit of the Association's objectives and to support and/or oppose and take necessary all and every action including legal recourse to represent, defend and support/oppose any such move, legislation, taxation or other concerned measure, imposition or enactment for the protection of legitimate rights, interests and work of members of the Association.
- xiii) to advise or to represent to the Central and State Governments, local authorities and other public bodies on all matters relating to biotechnology.
- xiv) to grant awards to persons and institutions for outstanding contributions in the furtherance of the objects of the Society.
- xv) to receive subscriptions and to accept grants of money, securities, endowments and property of any kind from Central and State Governments and other public or private organisations and individuals, on such terms as may seem expedient.
- xvi) to do all such other acts and things, either alone or in conjunction with other organisations, or persons as the Society may consider necessary, incidental or conducive to attainment of the above objects or any of them.
